I am a Fellow of the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries having qualified in 2008.

I previously studied at St Hugh's College, Oxford University and graduated with a BA (Hons) in Mathematical Sciences in 2001.

I joined Garvins, a small firm of consulting actuaries in 2001 as a trainee actuary, where I was involved in providing advice to trustees and employers of defined benefit and defined contribution occupational pension schemes. In early 2008 Garvins became part of Barnett Waddingham. I continued to work at Barnett Waddingham, taking on the role of a Qualified Pensions Actuary in July 2008.

In December 2010 I moved to Trigon Pensions Limited, where as a Consulting Actuary and Manager of the actuarial team, I helped to grow the actuarial side of the business. During my time at Trigon I held a Scheme Actuary certificate and took on a number of Scheme Actuary appointments to trustees of defined benefit occupational pension schemes. I worked with trustees of ongoing pension schemes, schemes which were in the Pension Protection Fund (PPF) assessment period and schemes being transferred to the Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS). I also advised trustees and employers on other aspects of pensions such as ways to reduce risk within pension schemes and managing the PPF levy. In addition to the actuarial work at Trigon, I took on managerial and HR roles for the actuarial team.

I joined Mathieson Consulting Limited in January 2015, where I have been preparing expert witness reports on divorce.

Mathieson Consulting has advised on over 1,000 different divorce proceedings over the past 10 years, undertaking a forensic analysis of benefit disclosure and advising both instructing solicitor and Counsel upon the options available and the ramifications for their clients.
