### **CURRICULUM VITAE**

I am a Fellow of the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries having qualified as an actuary in 2001.

In 1993 I graduated from the University of Leeds with a BSc (Hons) in Mathematics and Statistics. In 1997 I obtained a PhD in Statistics, again from the University of Leeds.

I joined Garvin Trustees Ltd, a firm of consulting actuaries which is now part of Barnett Waddingham, in 1997 as a trainee actuary and qualified in 2001. At Garvins I was involved in advising on occupational pension arrangements to trustees and employers covering both defined benefit and defined contribution pension arrangements. I held a Scheme Actuary certificate from 2004 until 2006.

From 2012 to 2016 I worked at Mathieson Consulting, writing, preparing and advising on expert witness reports in the areas of pensions on divorce, loss of pension rights on dismissal, negligence (pensions on divorce) and Inheritance Act cases. I rejoined Mathieson consulting in 2018, having worked at another firm of expert witnesses in the interim.
