I am a qualified actuary, having become a Fellow of the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries in 2009. I have over 13 years' experience of working in the UK pensions industry.

Since 2017, I have been working at Mathieson Consulting preparing and advising on expert witness reports in the areas of pensions on divorce, loss of pension rights on dismissal, negligence (pensions on divorce) and Inheritance Act cases.

Prior to joining Mathieson Consulting, I worked as a corporate pensions actuary at PwC, primarily advising companies on the risks and issues faced in operating defined benefit pension schemes. This work has included advising on pension scheme closure, production of FRS 102 disclosures, providing support in valuation discussions and carrying out liability management exercises. I also have served as a subject-matter expert in public and not-for-profit sector pension arrangements, focussing both on technical knowledge and business development in this area.

In my previous employment, I have also performed individual member calculations while working under a Scheme Actuary, including transfer value quotations, early/late retirement terms, pensions tax implications and also pension scheme valuations.

In 2004, I graduated from the University of Strathclyde with a BSc (Hons) in Mathematics, Statistics and Accounting. I am also a Fellow of the Royal Statistical Society.
